

Article XIII – Policy and Rules for Septic Disposal

- Septic waste receiving hours are Monday to Friday 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. from mid-April through mid-December. Winter receiving hours are 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. mid-December through mid-April. Emergencies may be excepted.
- All septic waste deliveries shall be to the treatment plant via Route 4.
- Septic waste delivery trucks shall not use engine brakes within 1000 feet of the treatment plant.
- Septic waste delivery trucks shall maintain proper speed when entering and leaving treatment plant property.
- No treatment plant septic waste delivery traffic shall park on Liberty Street or adjoining properties.
- Septic delivery trucks waiting to off-load, shall have their engines shut off.
- Upon complaint of violation of these regulations, SBSDD shall investigate by the following:
 - Obtaining the nature of violation
 - Obtaining name of septic waste hauler
 - Obtaining date and time of violation
 - Obtaining location of violationThe SBSDD reserves the right to suspend deliveries of any septic waste hauler at its discretion.
- Failure to comply with the policy and rules of this Article may result in a septic waste hauler's privileges being suspended.

Article XIV – SBSDD Community Relations

- The SBSDD will maintain a call line for the purpose of recording public comments regarding treatment plant and district operations.
- The SBSDD will maintain a web site providing news about the district and the opportunity for the public to comment on district and treatment plant operations.

- Incoming messages from the call line and web site will be transcribed and provided to trustees at monthly meetings. Action will be taken as determined appropriate by the SBSB Board of Trustees.
